Recipe of the Month by Meghan

Banana Chocolate Chip Bread

1 cup granulated sugar
4 ounces butter (softened)
1 ½ cup of mashed bananas
2 large eggs
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
1 ½ teaspoons baking powder
2 cups all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt

1 cup semisweet chocolate chips

Cream sugar and butter; beat the mashed bananas, eggs, and vanilla. Combine dry ingredients and stir into the first mixture just until moistened. Fold in chocolate chips until well incorporated. Pour batter into greased and floured 9x5x3-inch loaf pan. Cover loosely with a tent of aluminum foil. Bake at 325 degrees Fahren-

heit for 30 minutes. Remove foil and continue baking for 30 to 40 minutes or until wooden pick inserted tests done. Cool for 10 minutes, remove from pan and cool bread completely before slicing.

Do you like mentoring? Why?

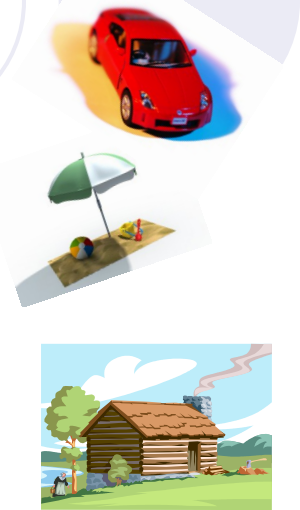
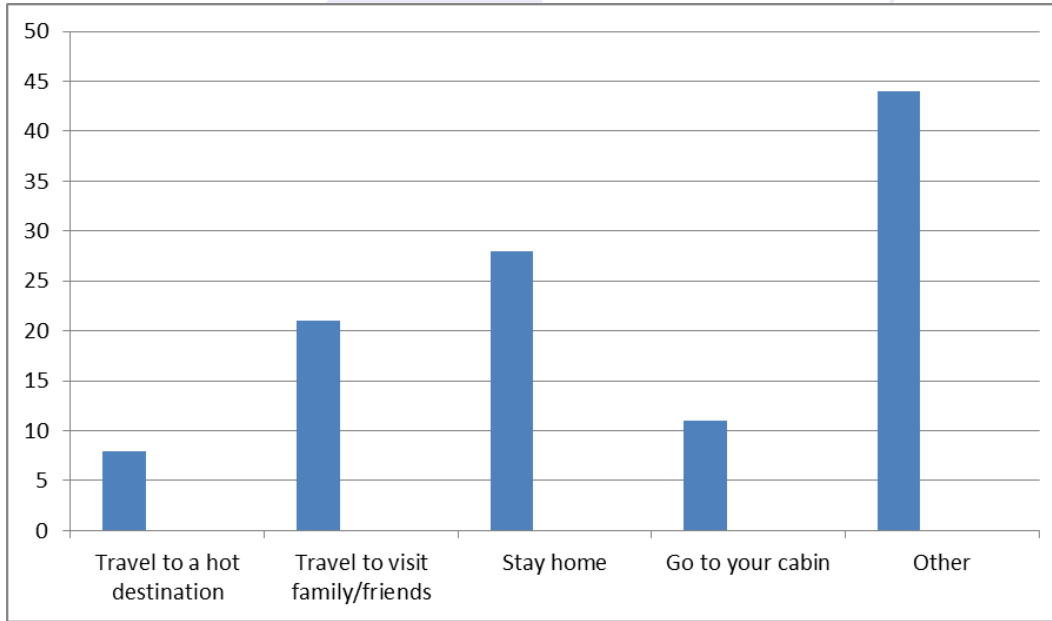
Paul- Yes I've worked with kids for awhile and it gets my mind off of hockey.
